Middle School Endorsement Courses

Payment Policy for programs that begin on or after July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018

Tuition per Credit Hour \$440

Payment Methods

Individual courses may be paid in full by check, cashier's check, Discover, Visa, or MasterCard, and are due prior to the 1st night of each corresponding course.

Total Due before 1st night of 1st course: \$1,320

The second course must be paid in full before the first night of the second course.

Total Due before 1st night of 2nd course: \$1,320

c. Both courses may be paid in full by check, cashier's check, Discover, Visa, or MasterCard. The 1st payment for the first course is due prior to the 1st night of the first course. Payment for the second course is due by the end of the 2nd course.

Total Due before 1st night of 1st Course: \$2,640

EDUC 767 - Early Adolescent Development 3 hours \$1,320

This course is designed to provide an understanding of the mental, physical, emotional, and social characteristics of early adolescents. The candidates will explore and analyze the unique developmental stages of the early adolescent. Another focus of the course is how to enhance school success by meeting the cognitive, physical, social, emotional, and moral developmental needs of adolescents. *(3 credit hours – 5-week course, online)*

EDUC 768 - Middle School Philosophy & Methodology 3 hours \$1,320

This course is designed to provide an understanding of middle school students and their uniqueness as adolescents. The candidate will examine the evolution of middle schools with particular emphasis on the rationale of a developmentally responsive school. The focus will be on the middle school organizational components – teaming, advisor/advisee, exploratory, and learning communities; and instruction – cooperative learning, student grouping, teacher strategies, and student learning styles and the roles teachers and administrators play in incorporating a guided, interdisciplinary, collaborative team approach that assists students during these fundamental transformative years.

A greater understanding of curriculum and instructional strategies at this level of learning will be provided. The practical experience will be focused upon the utilization of a variety of instructional strategies and assessments that meet the needs of the early adolescent. Reading and writing strategies will also be presented that are designed with the middle school learner in mind. *(3 credit hours – 5-week course, online)*
